- How you know the applicant
- How long you have known the applicant

B. Personal Information

- Your contact information (name, employment position, employer, phone number, and E-mail)

C. Applicant Ranking

- Indicate on a Likert scale the applicant's:
 - academic ability
 - communication (verbal and/or written)
 - motivation and initiative
 - actual/potential contribution to nursing
 - commitment to nursing

D. Reference Statement

- A brief statement about the applicant's strengths and potential for making a significant contribution to the nursing profession (maximum of **500** words)
